Our Programs

1. **Panna Model** - The Trajectory of interventional experiment is worth in exploring the collaborative efforts.

Panna model comprised all the 8 elements and 4 principles of comprehensive primary health care without deviating from its basic structure. Primary healthcare Foundation is equipped with tele-health, EHR, medical and paramedical staff, ensuring the data
