PHCF believes in partnering with other Organizations so as to achieve common goal of reaching to masses for provision of Healthcare services.

This year 2024-25 PHCF teamed up with following NGOs for implementation of various projects in the area of Mobile Medical Units, Ambulances, Up-gradation of Govt Primary health Centres as listed below.

Year 2024-25 PHCF received donations of amount Rs 183 Lakhs from Borderless World Foundation for running Mobile Medical Units at Pune, Amravati and Nagpur.

In the month of August 2025 PHCF received donation of Rs 25 Lakhs from M/s K Raheja Builders Pvt Ltd. for the supply of 300 sewing machines to deprived girls and women in Ratnagiri.

Year 2024-25 PHCF received donations from individual donors to the total of Rs 85 Lakhs for conducting various medical camp services in Pune, Amravati, Chhatrapati Sambhajnagar and Nagpur districts in Maharashtra.

A Operations of Mobile Medical Units (MMUs)

PHCF operates MMUs behalf of other NGOs due to its capabilities in Healthcare and overall Management of operations. Currently, four MMUs are being operated in Sambhaji Nagar regions in Maharashtra. Two more MMUs and one Mobile cancer screening Unit will operational in the month of July 24. The operation include recruitment of staff, induction, training, planning and monitoring the operations and reporting achievements against the set performance targets, reporting the same as well as maintaining and reporting of accounts

B Development of Software

With domain knowledge of primary healthcare and other fields, PHCF is in process of developing software s, which can be implemented by other likeminded NGOs to make their operations more effective.

C Base line and Impact Assessments

PHCF offers assistance to other NGOs for undertaking comprehensive studies such as Base line / Need assessment studies. This includes designing of study, Primary and secondary data collection, analysis, inference and preparation of Project Report. The assignments also include Village Health Profiling along with Need Assessments. Year 2024-25 PHCF did following Baseline and Impact assessment studies.

- 1) Baseline survey study was conducted for SBIF funded **Sanjeevani Clinic on Wheels** programme at Bandipore (J&K), Kargil (Ladakh) assigned by Borderless World Foundation.
